It is through their shining example to the community at large that the award takes its name.

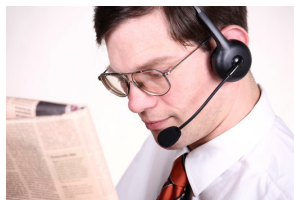
Nominations are called for at club level and forwarded to the District Shine On Awards committee - nomination forms are made available through this committee.
