GROUP STUDY EXCHANGE PROGRAM

EXCHANGING WITH D 4520 Brazil

24th August 2009

During this Rotary year, our District will be hosting a Group Study Exchange team from District 4520 in Brazil. This team is due to be in our District between 27th February 2010 and 26th March 2010.

There have been several changes to the program requirements and with this in mind, thought I would forward to each Rotary Club in our District, early notice that the GSE Sub-committee will, in the very near future, be looking for Clubs to provide an expression of interest in hosting this team and to provide a draft program that they might provide while hosting the team.

This exchange is a "general" exchange and does not have a specific vocational focus as last year. The Team from Brazil is being selected sometime during September so until that time, I cannot advise you of their various vocations but as soon as I know this, all clubs will be advised and it will be at that time, that the District GSE Sub-committee will be looking for interested clubs to host.

Because of the short time frame in which to organise the program and have it approved by both R.I. and D 4520, 45 days prior to departure of the teams, I send this notice to you all.

The following is a copy of some of the requirements from an e-mail received from R.I. recently:

Each host district itinerary must contain the following information:

- Names, street addresses and contact information of each host family
- Dates of stay with each host family
- Schedule of all planned activities
- Specified locations of all planned activities
- Names and contact information of any Rotarians who will be escorting the team
- Five (5) vocational days per team member,
- One or two days of isolated rest after arrival
- A half day mid-week to rest,
- One weekend day to rest, and
- Two days of mid-tour rest.
- Approval of the sponsor district

Could I suggest that Clubs think about this now and plan early if they would like to be involved. I will contact all Clubs again as soon as I have more information.
