1. Confirmation of minutes of the previous meeting.
2. **Treasurer's Report**

3. **Membership / Vocation**
 - Peter Ellis providing a voucher for the Peter Jacobs Award again.
 - A White card was received from Julie Halifax with the classification Adult Training and to be circulated around the club
4. **Rotary Foundation / International**
 - 17th October – Jungle Sale to be held from 9.00 – 3.00pm. Wendouree Breakfast will promote the Shelter box and run a display.
 - A flyer promoting the shelter box with a deposit slip to go into account
 - A wishing well to gather more funds for the shelter box was discussed.

 - Bowls day being looked at.

 - Friday night drinks happening again.
 - Croquet club twilight meeting next year.
 - Car club & Rotary club day being organised as a family and fun day.
 - Suggestion of creating some “loose change collection tins” to put around at businesses in Ballarat. Suggested that it be shaped like a shelter box .
7. **Public Relations / Youth**

8. **General Business**
